Many local Christian church members volunteer their time and gas to get First Fruits food boxes delivered to those who are homebound or with limited transportation. The bargain is not just the low price, but the high quality. Healthy, Happy, Good Food - for your body and your budget. There are no eligibility requirements, this is available to all. May's deadline to order by is 10:00am Friday, May 21, and the food pick up date is Saturday, May 29, between 8:30am-9:30am at 224 West Wilkins St. here in Jackson. Crew Roles Needed:		Crew Roles We'd Love to Have:	
Games	Plan and facilitate the themed games for all the kids during one evening of VBS. If supplies are needed, this person will organize donations or purchasing.	Sunday Morning Announcements	Prepare and lead written and verbal Sunday morning announcements to promote for kids to attend and recruit additional crew members. (In-advance role)
Crafts	Facilitate themed craft for all the kids during one evening of VBS. If supplies are needed, this person will organize donations or purchasing.	Skits	Act in daily skits during openings and/or closings.
STEM	Plan and facilitate themed science/STEM activity for all the kids during one evening of VBS. If supplies are needed, this person will organize donations or purchasing.	Snacks	Plan, prepare and distribute pre-packaged snacks that align with the theme daily. If supplies are needed, this person will organize donations or purchasing.
Music	Be up front and lead kids in song and dance during opening and closing each day.	Waiting Activities	Prepare and lead themed activities for children who complete daily activities early.
Bible Storyteller	Share God's Word in the Bible story each day.	Parent Resources	Curate and prepare a table of resources or prayer time that might be useful for parents of VBS children. (In-advance role)
Technology	Run the videos and other technology needs during the opening and closing each day.	Prayer Points	Write and submit the prayer focus areas for the congregation to be praying for this ministry every couple of weeks leading up to VBS. (In-advance role)
Registration	Collect and organize registration forms. Distribute t-shirts. Direct children to their groups/areas. Count offerings daily.	Writing team	Join in the writing of skits and one day of full materials for the VBS program. (In-advance role)
Group Leaders/ Helpers	Be responsible for a group of children. Lead them in participating in all activities.	Promotion	Create and distribute flyers and promotional information to the community. (In-advance role)
